MATHEMATICS

We shall begin our learning by exploring mass, capacity, and temperature, we will then move onto fractions. Later in the term we will learn how to tell the time, explore statistics, and end the term with position and direction.

GEOGRAPHY / HISTORY

Our topic learning this term will be focussed on learning about and comparing Sri Lanka and Charlestown; exploring if all countries look the same. This will be closely linked with comparing villages, town and cities. We will also be studying Charles Rashleigh.

SCIENCE

Our science focus throughout the first half of the summer term will be plants. We shall spend time planting beans, dissecting plants to identify the correct parts, and exploring the world of plants around our school. In the second part of the summer term we will explore living things and their habitats, including microhabitats and food chains.

In R.E, we will be learning about the importance of Bible stories and what they mean to Christians and how Jesus gives instructions on how Christians should behave.

Our DT will then progress to make a moving picture, with flaps and sliders linking to our topic learning. The second half of the summer term will be focused on art, creating a sea themed picture using techniques from our focused artist Van Gogh.

Being our Best will start the term, where we begin an understanding of keeping clean and healthy, how our body works and why. The second half of the term will focus on developmental changes, as well as subjects such as 'No means no!'
